On Wednesday March 24th, members of the command staff from Central City Precinct were on hand for the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the first children’s palliative care home in the Southwest- Ryan House, 110 W. Merrell Street.

Ryan House offers eight rooms for children and three family suites for short-term medical respite and palliative care. Other areas include an outdoor playground, a hydrotherapy room and a soundproof music room. Families can participate in arts and crafts, pet and music therapy, advocacy, consultation, emotional and spiritual support.

Families can use Ryan House for planned and unscheduled respite care, up to 28 days a year at no cost.

We wish Ryan House continued success as they provide this much needed service to families all over the Southwest.

Heart Healthy Gazpacho

- 28 oz. Can crushed Tomato (low sodium)
- 3 cups V8 Juice (low sodium)
- 1/2 red onion, chopped
- 1 red and 1 green bell pepper, chopped
- 2 1/2 cups hot house cucumber cubed
- 2 cloves garlic
- 1/3 cup carrot, diced
- 1/4 cup each, fresh basil, oregano, Italian Parsley
- 1/3 cup red wine vinegar
- 1/3 cup fresh lemon juice
- Tabasco (to taste)
- Diced Celery, (optional)
- Olive oil, to drizzle (Optional)

In a food processor, in batches, process the first 8 ingredients until a smooth but slightly textured consistency. Add vinegar, lemon juice and Tabasco to taste. Chill for several hours or even better overnight. Serves up great with a sandwich for a light and quick weeknight supper. Top with diced celery and a drizzle of olive oil if you'd like. Enjoy!
